



Singer-entertainer extraordinaire, Bobby Valli has been touring America for over four decades. Bobby is very proud to say he is the younger brother of music icon Frankie Valli. Invited to sing at Carnegie Hall with Bruce Springsteen along with members of The Young Rascals, the act was titled *Bobby Valli and His Jersey Guys*.

Bobby performed on a PBS Special, *Rock, Rhythm and Doo Wop*, and had the distinct pleasure of singing the closing number, “Let’s Hang On,” with his brother Frankie Valli.

Bobby has been featured, appearing in musical acts, on Richard Nader’s and Bowzer’s oldies shows, with a multitude of other famous recording artists, such as Rock and Roll Hall of Famers: Dion, The Drifters, The Shirelles, Jay and The Americans and many, many more. The list goes on and on.
